THE ALLEN ORGAN COMPANY ANNOUNCES A NEW INSTALLATION IN THE NATION'S LARGEST SYMPHONY HALL

The internationally acclaimed CINCINNATI SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA has chosen a *Four-manual, Eighty-stop Allen Renaissance™ Organ* for permanent installation in Music Hall in Cincinnati, Ohio, the nation's largest symphonic concert hall. The instrument was designed to fill the many and diverse musical demands of the repertoire of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra, the fifth oldest orchestra in the United States, now under the leadership of Paavo Jarvi, as well as the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra conducted by Erich Kunzel.

The organ was built in the Macungie, Pennsylvania manufacturing facility of Allen Organ Company, the world's largest builder of organs. Allen was the pioneer in the development of digital sound more than thirty years ago.

Organists performing on the Cincinnati Music Hall instrument will have at their disposal the authentic sound of winded pipes digitally sampled from the finest organs in the world. The custom audio system of the large organ is installed with specially designed movable speaker towers allowing not only flexibility of placement on the stage, but also the ability to be easily stored when the organ is not in use. The Allen organ is also particularly practical for a symphonic venue since it requires no maintenance or tuning, is not affected by changes in temperature or environment, and can be ready for use very quickly at any time.
